Educational: Reading forms the foundation for a love of learning. What's more, studies show that reading out loud can actually wire a child's brain to recognize patterns and sequences and predict

outcomes — cognitive skills that affect all areas of life.

Shared-reading also sharpens listening and conversation skills, sparks the imagination, and expands a child's knowledge of the world around them.

Emotional: The intimate experience of shared-reading yields important lessons about behavior, feelings, and the enduring bonds of relationships. Shared-reading is a gift for parents and children alike who may be missing special moments with each other. Our Family Connections program allows absent parents an opportunity to rekindle emotional closeness as well as impart important lessons, ease difficult transitions, heal personal pain, and celebrate family life through the gift of shared-reading.

Reading with young children through our Community Connections program is a unique way to give at-risk high school students an opportunity to give back to their community in a positive way while building leadership experience. In addition to the benefits afforded the high schools students, the young children with whom they read are benefitting from the educational and emotional benefits of shared-reading.
